# Day 4: Las Vegas - West Grand Canyon - Hoover Dam - Las Vegas

This morning, explore the **Grand Canyon West Rim**. Unlike the South and North Rim, Grand Canyon West is not part of the Grand Canyon National Park, located within the Hualapai Indian Reservation at the western Grand Canyon corridor. The Hualapai Indian Tribe has constructed a tourist attraction that they named "The West Rim of the Grand Canyon". You will have the option to walk on the **Grand Canyon Skywalk**, a glass bridge that extends

out into open space from the canyon edge. There is nothing but glass under your feet it feels like walking out into "air" suspended 4,000 feet above the canyon floor and the Colorado River. It is an amazing sensation with 360 degree, incredible views. You may also take an optional helicopter or boat tour to see the true beauty of the Grand Canyon. You will then visit **Hoover Dam** which is a concrete arch-gravity dam in the Black Canyon of the Colorado River, on the border between Arizona and Nevada. When it was completed in 1936, it was both the world's largest electric-power generating station and the world's largest concrete structure.

## Day 5: Ethel M Chocolate Factory - Botanical Cactus Gardens - Los Angeles

#### Day 7: Arrival - New York City

Meet and greet at airport (Baggage Claim Area) then transfer to hotel for rest.

Pick-up services are available for JFK, LGA and EWR airports. Please arrive at EWR (Newark Liberty International Airport) for convenient.

The New York City night tour (optional) start with an experience of the Big Apple bright night lights and encounters the wonderful NYC landmarks in a beautiful night tour. Abraham Lincoln and inscriptions of two well-known speeches by Lincoln. Visit the Jefferson Memorial, dedicated to Thomas Jefferson, an American Founding Father and the third president of the United States. National Museum of Natural History, part of the Smithsonian Institution and is the world's finest museum and research complex. The Museum is dedicated to stimulating curiosity, discovery, and learning about the natural world through its unmatched research, collections, exhibitions, and educational outreach programs. Also see the White House the world's famous building, which is the residence and workplace for the President of the U.S. The Vietnam Veterans Memorial designed by Maya Ying Lin and honors members of the U.S. armed forces fought in the Vietnam War and died in service or are missing.

## Day 10: D.C. - Hershey - Corning Museum of Glass - Niagara Falls
