Day 3 Los Angeles - Las Vegas

Day 4 Las Vegas - West Grand Canyon - Hoover Dam - Las Vegas

This morning, explore the Grand Canyon West Rim. Unlike the South and North Rim, Grand Canyon West is not part of the Grand Canyon National Park, located within the Hualapai Indian Reservation at the western Grand Canyon corridor. The Hualapai Indian Tribe has constructed a tourist attraction that they named "The West Rim of the Grand Canyon". You will have the option to walk on the Grand Canyon Skywalk, a glass bridge that extends out into open spaces from the



canyon edge. There is nothing but glass under your feet and it feels like walking out into "air" suspended 4,000 feet above the canyon floor and the Colorado River. It is an amazing sensation with 360 degree, incredible views. Optional rides also available for helicopter and boat tour to see the true beauty of the Grand Canyon. Visit Hoover Dam which is a concrete arch-gravity dam in the Black Canyon by Colorado River, on the border between Arizona and Nevada. When it was completed in 1936, it was both the world's largest electric-power generating station and the world's largest concrete structure.
